

Mini Motos – The Law and You

To use on a road, pavement or public place you must:

- * be over 16 years of age
- * wear an approved helmet
- * have road tax
- * have a driving licence, tax and insurance
- * have at least a provisional licence
- * have undergone Compulsory Basic Training
- * ensure the bike has lights, number plate and sufficient tread on the tyres
- * have an MOT if the bike is over three years old



You cannot ride a mini moto on private land without permission of the landowner
