APPEAL FOR WITNESSES

Attempted theft – Cargenbridge

Around 2000 hours on Monday 9 November 2009 the following two men were disturbed at the premises of Parkdale Garage, Dalbeattie Road, Cargenbridge, Dumfries. The men are described as (1) male, 20s, 6' tall, slim, local accents. (2) male, 20s, slim build, wearing a beige hooded top and blue jeans. On being disturbed a blue Daihatsu 4 x 4 was seen to leave the premises.
