Window smashed – Dumfries

A large showroom window at Crossflags Showroom, Annan Road in Dumfries was smashed sometime overnight Thursday 11/Friday 12 February 2010.

Window smashed – Dumfries

A window in a green Citroen C5 car was smashed sometime around 1550 hours on Friday 12 February 2010. A group of youths who were seen the area at the time throwing stoned are thought to be responsible and police want to trace them.

Trailer theft – Waterbeck
